Research Objectives and Methodology





Research Objectives and Methodology


- The Maine Office of Tourism has commissioned DPA to conduct a visitor research program designed to provide information on tourism activity in Maine and explore the motivations of visitors. The Maine Office of Tourism Visitor Research Program is conducted online, with survey participants recruited from the ResearchNow national online panel.
- Information is gathered using three main surveys on an ongoing basis:
 - Regional Travel Survey
 - Includes travelers living in New England, NJ, NY, PA, DE, MD, DC, and Eastern Canada;
 - Respondents are screened to see if they have taken an overnight trip to Maine in the past four weeks. If they have, they are asked to complete the Maine Overnight Visitors Survey.
 - Maine Day Visitor Survey
 - Includes travelers living within Maine or within a 100-mile radius of Maine's borders who have taken a day trip in Maine that is at least 50 miles from home within the past four weeks.
 - National Omnibus Survey
 - Includes a nationally balanced sample of US residents; and
 - Used to determine the incidence of travel nationwide and Maine's share of that travel.
- This report outlines results from calendar year 2013, with travel occurring between January 2013 and December 2013. Data was collected between January 1st and December 15th, 2013. The number of completed statewide surveys collected for each research component are as follows:
 - Maine Overnight Visitor Survey 2,675
 - Maine Day Visitor 1,685
 - National Omnibus Survey 17,591



Aroostook County's overnight visitation is almost evenly split between American and Canadian visitors.

- Ontario sends the highest proportion of overnight visitors to Aroostook County, followed by New York and New Brunswick. In-state residents comprise 11% of Aroostook's overnight visitors.
- Aroostook County attracts a higher proportion of Canadian visitors than the rest of the State of Maine and a lower proportion of domestic visitors, especially from Massachusetts.






Overnight Visitors: *Trip Experience*


Primary Purpose of Overnight Trips






Shopping Activities



Top Towns/Cities Visited







State/ Province of Residence




Day Q1A. In what State or Province do you reside?





Primary Purpose of Day Trips


















Top Towns/Cities Visited

Comparisons

- Visitors to the Aroostook County region and visitors to the State of Maine as a whole differ in a few areas. These variations can be seen primarily in the visitor origin, as well as their reasons for traveling and the activities they participate in while visiting.
- Highlights:
 - Visitor Origin
 - A greater proportion of overnight and day visitors from Canada, especially New Brunswick.
 - A lesser proportion of overnight and day visitors from the United States, especially Massachusetts.
 - Visitor Demographics
 - A lesser proportion of overnight visitors over the age of 55, and a lower average age of visitors.
 - A lesser proportion of day visitors who have completed college.
 - A greater proportion of day visitors who are married.
 - Primary Purpose of Trip
 - Day visitors more likely to be traveling for shopping
 - Day visitors less likely to be visiting for a special event or to experience great cuisine
 - Day and overnight visitors less likely to be visiting for outdoor recreation
 - Overnight visitors less likely to be visiting:
 - To enjoy nature
 - To get away to relax
 - To tour/see the sites
