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# Research Objectives and Methodology




### **Research Objectives and Methodology**

- The Maine Office of Tourism has commissioned DPA to conduct a visitor research program designed to provide information on tourism activity in Maine and explore the motivations of visitors. The Maine Office of Tourism Visitor Research Program is conducted online, with survey participants recruited from two national online panels Research Now and Instantly (formerly Usamp).
- Information is gathered on an ongoing basis through three surveys:
  - Maine Overnight Visitor Survey
    - Includes travelers living in New England, NJ, NY, PA, DE, MD, DC, and Eastern Canada
    - Have taken an overnight trip to Maine in the past four weeks
  - Maine Day Visitor Survey
    - Includes travelers living within Maine or within a 100-mile radius of Maine's borders
    - Have taken a day trip in Maine that is at least 50 miles from home within the past four weeks
  - National Omnibus Survey
    - Includes a nationally balanced sample of US residents
    - To determine the incidence of travel nationwide and Maine's share of that travel
- Survey results were collected during calendar year 2015 for travel to Maine occurring from December 2014 through November 2015. The number of respondents participating in each survey is:
  - Maine Overnight Visitor Survey 2,779
  - Maine Day Visitor 1,755
  - National Omnibus Survey 17,812



### **Research Objectives and Methodology**

- The following report summarizes the results among visitors to the Aroostook County tourism region during 2015, including:
  - 79 overnight visitors, and
  - 55 day visitors.
- Throughout this report, data for the Aroostook County tourism region will be presented alongside data for the State of Maine as a whole. Statistically significant differences between the tourism region and the State were calculated at the 95% confidence level and are noted throughout by < >.
- Statistically significant differences between 2014 and 2015
  are also highlighted for both the Aroostook County region
  and the State of Maine. A statistically significant increase
  from the previous year is indicated by green text, and a
  significant decrease from the previous year is indicated by
  red text.





## Overnight Visitors: Traveler Description



### **Overnight Visitor Demographics**


- Overnight visitors to Aroostook County are 38 years old, on average, and have average annual household incomes just under \$95,000. Two-thirds have at least a college degree and 55% are married. Threefourths are employed full-time.
- Overnight visitors to Aroostook County are younger, on average, than visitors to Maine overall.

## Three in four overnight visitors to Aroostook County are from the U.S., with most arriving from the Mid-Atlantic region.


 <u>Fewer</u> overnight visitors from New England visit Aroostook County than Maine overall, specifically those from Massachusetts.






## One in three visitors to Aroostook county are visiting for the first time, a significantly higher proportion than for the State overall.

## Two in five overnight visitors to Aroostook County are traveling with children.





## The most common reason for an overnight VFR trip to this region is a general visit to see friends.


### **Primary Purpose of Overnight VFR Trips**





## Business visitors to Aroostook County are most likely to cite a *meeting* as the primary purpose of their overnight business trip.


### **Primary Purpose of Overnight Business Trips**





### The most commonly pursued interest areas by overnight visitors to Aroostook County are touring/sightseeing and shopping.


Visitors to the Aroostook County region are less likely to pursue food/beverage/culinary interests than are visitors to Maine overall.

In analyzing both interest and importance together, food/beverage/culinary activities are less important to Aroostook County visitors than they are to visitors to the State as a whole.






Importance Index = percentage selecting category as interest area X percentage ranking same interest area as #1 most important






## Nearly half of visitors to Aroostook County interested in food/beverage/culinary activities ate lobster or other local seafood while visiting.






## Hiking/climbing/backpacking and camping are the most common active outdoor activities among Aroostook County overnight visitors.






## Visiting historic sites or museums is the most common history/culture activity pursued among overnight visitors to this region.








## Visitors to Aroostook County participate in a variety of family fun/children's activities.

### Family Fun/Children's Activities



## Aroostook State Park and the Acadian Village are the most visited attractions/locations by overnight visitors to Aroostook County.





### **Day Visitor Demographics**

- Day visitors to Aroostook County are about 43 years old and earn just under \$80,000 annually. Six in ten have a college degree and are employed full-time.
- Day visitors to Aroostook County trend younger than visitors to the State of Maine as a whole.



### More day visitors to Aroostook County arrive from Canada than from the United States.


- Aroostook County day visitors are <u>less</u> likely to be from the U.S. and <u>more</u> likely to be from Canada than day visitors to the State as a whole.
- A higher proportion of day visitors from New Brunswick visit Aroostook County than the rest of the State,
   while a lower proportion of day visitors from Massachusetts and New Hampshire visit the region.

### **State/ Province of Residence**








# Day Visitors: *Trip Experience*



## More than half of day visitors in Aroostook County for a VFR trip cite a general visit to friends or relatives as the primary purpose of their trip.


### **Primary Purpose of Day VFR Trips**

### **Primary Purpose of Day Business Trips**



## **Shopping** is the most common interest area among day visitors to Aroostook County.


Fewer day visitors to Aroostook County than those to Maine as a whole list touring/sightseeing, active
outdoor activities, and water activities as an interest area they wanted to pursue during this trip to Maine.



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## When analyzing both interest and importance in deciding to visit, shopping ranks highest by a large margin among day visitors to Aroostook County.

• The *Importance Index* for Aroostook County shows <u>more</u> importance placed on *shopping* than for day visitors to the State as a whole and <u>less</u> importance placed on *food/beverage/culinary activities* and *touring/sightseeing*.





## Among day visitors to Aroostook County interested in touring or sightseeing activities, the highest percentage of visitors participate in *general sightseeing*.

• Day visitors to Aroostook County are more likely to be *viewing fall colors* on their visit than are visitors to Maine as a whole.






## **Enjoying unique Maine food or beverages** is the most common food/beverage/culinary activity among day visitors to Aroostook County.








# The most common non-water active outdoor activity among Aroostook County day visitors is hiking/climbing/backpacking.






# Visiting historic sites or museums is the most common history or culture activity participated in by day visitors to Aroostook County.



# Aroostook County day visitors interested in shopping are most likely to engage in *general shopping at malls and downtown*.

- General shopping at malls and downtown is more popular among day visitors to the Aroostook County region as compared to Maine visitors as a whole.
- Maine visitors overall engage in *outlet shopping* and *shopping for unique, locally produced goods* in higher proportions than Aroostook County visitors.





# Comparison of *Aroostook County*Visitors to Maine Visitors



- Visitors to Aroostook County and visitors to the State of Maine as a whole differ in a number of areas. These variations can be seen in some visitor demographics, the origin of the visitors, and the activities they participate in while visiting.
- Visitor origin closely follows the geographic location of Aroostook County its proximity to Canada and greater distance from New England states such as Massachusetts.
- Highlights Aroostook County vs. State visitors:

#### **Visitor Origin**

- A greater proportion of overnight and day visitors from Canada, specifically New Brunswick.
- A smaller proportion of overnight and day visitors from New England, specifically Massachusetts.

#### **Visitor Demographics**

• Both overnight and day visitors are **younger** on average.



Highlights Continued:

#### **Trip Interest Areas – Overnight Visitors**

• Less likely to want to pursue food/beverage/culinary activities while visiting.

#### **Trip Interest Areas – Day Visitors**

• Less likely to want to pursue water activities, active outdoor activities, and touring/sightseeing while visiting.

#### Maine Trip Interests and Importance (Importance Index) – Overnight and Day Visitors

• Less likely to place importance on food/beverage/culinary activities.

#### Maine Trip Interests and Importance (Importance Index) – Day Visitors

 More likely to place importance on shopping and less likely to place importance on touring/sightseeing.

  - Eating lobster or other local seafood





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
